

Mandatory Reporting Requirements

Who must report	Any person
Standard of Knowledge	Reason to believe that a child has been subjected to abuse or neglect or who observes a child being subjected to conditinos or circumstances which would reasonably result in abuse or neglect.
Definition of Applicable Victim	A child is a person under the age of 18.
Reports Made To	Local Utah Division of Child and Family Services or the nearest peace officer, law enforcement agency. Please see http://www.dcfhs.utah.gov/locations.htm for the appropriate local Division office and 24-hour phone numbers.
Contents of Report	Not provided
Timing/Other Procedures	Telephone report to be made immediately, followed by a written report within 48 hours, if requested.
Other	<p>* Willful failure to report is a Class B misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, a fine of \$1,000, or both</p> <p>* If a confession was made directly to the clergyman or priest by the perpetrator, then the clergyman or priest is not required to report the abuse, but they are not exempt from any other efforts required by law to prevent further abuse or neglect by the perpetrator.</p> <p>* Any person who has reason to believe that a child has died as a result of abuse or neglect shall report that fact to (a) the local law enforcement agency, who shall report to the county attorney or district attorney and (b) the appropriate medical examiner.</p> <p>* In addition to the duty to report child abuse or neglect, any educator who has reasonable cause to believe that a student may have been physically or sexually abused by a school employee shall immediately report that information to the school pricipal, superintendent, or to the office. A school administrator receiving such report must immediately report the information to the office.</p>
